FLOOR FIXING AND WASTE PIPE HOLES


The Wash Unit is fixed to the floor via 2 fixing points in the base moulding.


Option1: The pedestal can be drilled anywhere within the 2 side plumbing access points to allow water & waste pipes to enter / exit the Wash Unit.

Option2: Water & waste pipes to enter / exit the wash unit from the bottom of the pedestal.

Option3: water & waste pipes to enter / exit the wash unit from the back of the pedestal.
