Read Before Use

Expert Peel is a highly active exfoliation product and should be used only by qualified skin care professionals after thoroughly reviewing product training materials and performing a thorough skin consultation on their clients to determine if appropriate to use. This product is for professional use only, and is NOT for consumer use.

NOTE: When applying Expert Peel, do not apply on or near the eye area and exercise caution near the nostrils and mouth areas.

IMPORTANT:

Due to the highly active nature of this formula, DO NOT use with ultrasonic, microdermabrasion, or other skin care technologies.

- Expert Peel is a highly active exfoliation product and should be used only by qualified skin care professionals after thoroughly reviewing product training materials and performing a thorough skin consultation on their clients to determine if appropriate to use.
- Do not apply over or near eyes.
- Do not use on broken skin.
- Not recommended for clients with compromised immune function or other conditions that results in thinned skin or slowed wound healing, clients with sensitive skin, or in cases where you are unfamiliar with the client's reaction to assertive exfoliation services.
- Ensure that clients have discontinued the use of prescription medications on the area to be applied for at least one week prior to service.
- Perform a patch test in an inconspicuous area prior to use.
- Do not use this product with abrasive brushes, skin care technology, or devices of any kind.
- Do not combine with abrasive products and other exfoliants.
- Always rinse and remove thoroughly from the skin with cool water. Do not rub the skin or use abrasive towels or sponges.

Sunburn Alert: This product contains an alpha hydroxy acid (AHA) that may increase your skin's sensitivity to the sun and particularly the possibility of sunburn. Use a sunscreen, wear protective clothing, and limit sun exposure while using this product and for a week afterwards.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Expert Peel may cause a tingling sensation on the skin. Be sure to constantly check in with your client, never leave client unattended. If the client reports discomfort, immediately and thoroughly remove the product with cold water.

Be sure to recommend appropriate after care for the home care regimen, including extra emphasis on moisturization and sunscreen application, as well as avoidance of at home exfoliation for at least one week following the service.

Client will experience slight redness and tightness following the service and may experience light flaking and peeling several days after service.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- Begin with gently cleansed skin that is completely dry.
- If this is the first time using this product on the client, start with a small patch test in an inconspicuous area of the skin.
- Dispense two to three pumps of product into a cup and apply with a fan brush to the areas desired, being extremely cautious to avoid the eye area, nasal/mouth areas, and any areas of sensitized or broken skin.
- Allow to set on the skin for up to three minutes, consistently checking in with your client with regards to their comfort. Remove immediately with cool water if client reports moderate discomfort. First time clients should begin with an application time of no more than 40 seconds to one minute.
- Remove thoroughly with cold water, ensuring all traces of product are thoroughly removed.
- Follow with a rich layer of moisturizer, then Shade SPF30 if the service is performed during daytime.
